Dear parents and carers of Year 6,

Residential Visit to RobinWood – Friday, 13th July 2018

It's almost time for our residential visit and we're very excited! We are writing today to clarify some final details for you. You'll remember most of this from our initial meeting way back at the start of the year and especially those of you who had children attend last year too. But, as some of you have asked us individual questions, we thought it best to clarify for everyone.

Children attending the Residential

- Children should arrive at normal time on Friday and **do not** have to wear school uniform.
- We are aiming to leave at 9.30am on Friday morning and plan to return at 3.30pm on Sunday. We are aware that there might be quite an important football match on if all goes well tonight so please ensure we have your most recent and up to date mobile number so that we can text you any updates. If we get through to the final, we are aiming to be back at Manor Green by 3:30pm.
- Please bring bags into school via the main entrance. Doors will be open to do this from 8:30am. Please place bags on the stage area at the back of the hall.
- Children do not require a packed lunch as food is provided by RobinWood once we arrive. Remember that, if it's helpful, our optional breakfast club is open from 8:20am where children only pay for what they eat. There is no charge to attend this club.
- If your child requires medication (that has been prescribed by their doctor), you will need to complete a medication consent form to give us permission to administer. This form is available from the main office or on our school website. If we do not have this form completed and returned, we will not be able to administer medication. If the medication is not prescribed by a doctor, then we will not be able to administer it.
- All food is provided by RobinWood and you have already identified any specific dietary requirements so please do not worry about this. As previously mentioned, children should not bring snacks as children are not allowed to eat in the dormitories. This is RobinWood's rule, not ours.
- There is a tuck shop available. Children will need a maximum of £2 to spend.
- Finally, please enjoy your weekend away knowing that your children will be safe and happy whilst being encouraged to push themselves to achieve great things!

Children not attending the Residential

- Children should attend school as normal on Friday in their uniform.
- We have arranged a visit from Active Tameside on Friday where children will take part in an afternoon of fun competitive games and activities. As such, children will need their Manor Green PE kit and a full water bottle.
- Children will be dismissed at the usual time, in the usual way.
