Since our sponsor, Focus Education, established us in May 2012, the Trust steadily grew to fifteen primary academies between 2013-2017. Within the fifteen academies we have over 6,000 children, more than 900 staff and 100 governors; every one of them is valuable to us and we have high expectations that all our academies will be the best they can for your child. Attending a Focus-Trust academy means your child will be provided with a great education in a high-quality learning environment. We are fortunate to have excellent Principals and Head Teachers, staff teams and local governing boards.
