Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to you today to inform you of some updates with regards to steps we are taking as a school during this challenging and unprecedented time.

In light of the Prime Minister's address yesterday, please ring school on the first day of absence to notify us if you are self-isolating for 14 days. There will not be a requirement to do so on subsequent days. If your child is absent due to self-isolating we will record the absence as a Y code. This is absence due to exceptional circumstances, this is treated differently from an illness.

Following further risk assessment, we will be suspending the use of home reading books for the time being. Children will continue to enjoy a rich diet in school and please continue to encourage them to read books of their choice at home.
