### Uniform Consultation – Results

I am writing to you today to share the results of our recent uniform consultation.

In total, we had 267 responses to the survey from parents, carers, staff and children and the results are as follows:

- School logo – 66.3% of those surveyed think that our logo represents our school well. **There will be no change to the school logo.**
- Polo shirts and gingham dresses – 56.2% of those surveyed support the suggestion to change to white polo shirts and return to green gingham dresses. **This change will come in to effect in September 2020.**

In the spirit of democracy and transparency, the breakdown of results and a selection of the comments shared are on the second page of this letter.

To support you in the transition from yellow polo shirts to white, school will be pleased to provide each child who will be on roll in September 2020 with a free white polo shirt. Mrs. Miles will be in touch later in the year with details about this.

Please remember that the changes do not come in to full effect until September 2020 and our amended uniform policy will be shared with you as soon as it is finalised. If you choose to purchase a green gingham dress for your child to wear this academic year, that is absolutely fine.

I would like to thank you for your contributions to our uniform consultation.






## Who completed the survey?
